## 2023-2024 7th Grade Required Immunization

### **All students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade need additional immunizations, which include:**

- Tdap-Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis
- Second MMR
- Second Varicella

Please submit a current copy of your child's immunization record to the school office as proof of immunization.

Students entering the 7th grade may need further immunizations if they previously had a personal belief exemption. SB 277 changed the law that only medical exemptions are valid in the state of California. 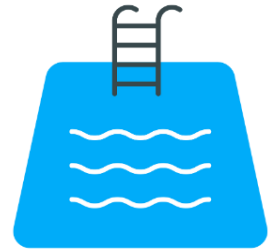
