7th Grade Immunization Requirements for 2026-2027

Dear 6th Grade Parents/Guardians:

Before your child can start 7th grade, the following immunizations are required:

- Tdap booster (on or after the 7th birthday)
- 2 doses of Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine

Please follow up with your child's health care provider to schedule his/her vaccination, and bring documentation of immunizations or a medical exemption to the school office, as soon as possible, to ensure that your child may begin the 7th grade school year without delays.

CAASPP Testing in Spring 2026

Exámenes CAASPP en la primavera de 2026

Dear Arena Families,

All students enrolled in Arena Elementary School are required to take the CAASPP (California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress). Below is the schedule for testing this spring which will begin after Spring Break.

CAASPP Testing will include the following for Spring 2026:

Students in Grades 3 – 8 will each take two ELA tests and two math tests, called (CAASPP) for English Language Arts/Literacy (ELA) and CAASPP for Mathematics. They each include a Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) and a Performance Task (PT).

Students in Grades 5 & 8 will each take the California Science Test (CAST).

Estimadas familias de Arena:

Todos los estudiantes matriculados en la Escuela Primaria Arena deben presentar la Evaluación de Rendimiento y Progreso Estudiantil de California (CAASPP). A continuación, se presenta el calendario de exámenes de esta primavera, que comenzará después de las vacaciones de primavera.

Los exámenes CAASPP incluirán lo siguiente para la primavera de 2026:

Los estudiantes de 3.º a 8.º grado presentarán dos exámenes de Lengua y Literatura Inglesas (ELA) y dos de Matemáticas (CAASPP) cada uno, y cada uno incluye una Prueba Adaptativa Computacional (CAT) y una Prueba de Rendimiento (PT).

Los estudiantes de 5.º y 8.º grado presentarán el Examen de Ciencias de California (CAST).

April - May 2026 CAASPP Testing Dates:

- 4th Grade CAASPP: April 29-May 13
- 5th Grade CAASPP: April 29-May 13
- 8th Grade CAASPP: May 4 -May 28

May 2026 CAASPP and CAST Testing Dates:

- 3rd Grade CAASPP: May 11-20
- 5th Grade CAST: May 6
- 6th Grade CAASPP: May 7-26
- 7th Grade CAASPP: May 7-26
- 8th Grade CAST: May 29

The data the CAASPP provides helps us to improve our academic programs. Thank you in advance for your child's participation.

You can help by:

1. Ensuring your child gets enough sleep the night before the test.
2. Helping your child get a nutritious breakfast with protein the morning of each test.
3. Talking to your child about trying their best on the test.
