Dear Senior class parents,

You and your Senior student are graciously invited to attend a short but mandatory Senior Class Student/Parent Meeting on Tuesday March 31st at the PAHS Library from 5:30-6:00pm, to review the class budget, review procedures and plans, and sign contracts for the Senior class trip to Paintball Jungle and Six Flags/Discovery Kingdom in Vallejo, which has been planned for Thursday 23 April through Friday 24 April.

We will review the class budget, review the contract, procedures, timeline and rules for the Senior class trip at this meeting. In addition, your questions about our Senior class trip will be answered. This trip has been carefully scheduled so as to not conflict with AP tests, Prom, and other important Senior events. We intend to leave PAHS early in the morning on Thursday 23 April and return Friday April 24, traveling on a charter bus seating 35 passengers. We need to know if every student will attend by April 17, to best save money booking hotels and activities.

Every student is invited to attend the class trip, however, forms need to be returned by April 17, along with a deposit fee of \$35 per person. This deposit will be used to reserve room on the bus and at the hotel for your student, as well as cover the cost of a Thursday night class dinner, tip for the bus driver, and other unanticipated trip costs. Any funds not needed for the trip will be used to honor Class of 2015 student Jason Marquez, who is missed by all, and will never be forgotten.

Please read over the attached agenda and contract for the trip, attend the Tuesday night meeting to have your questions answered, and return the contract to Katie or Cheryl by April 17, with your signatures and payment.

Note that our class meeting will be followed by the PAHS Sports Awards ceremony at 6pm. We encourage all Seniors and their parents to attend both events (class meeting and sports awards), to show PAHS Pirate Pride and school spirit, and to inspire the underclassmen.

Class sweatshirts have arrived, and our Seniors are wearing them with Pirate Pride! Seniors have raised enough money for our class trip, and have chosen a destination that is both affordable, and enjoyable.

Fourth Quarter and Spring bring a plethora of end of year activities, including scholarship applications and interviews, a renewed effort to maintain or improve grades, college campus visits and placement tests, photo deadlines for yearbook, the Senior Slide Show for graduation, Prom, AP tests, and more.
