## **PRE-IMPLEMENTATION TRAINING BENCHMARKS**

### **Leadership Residency Outcomes**

- Leader has a concise, compelling articulation of their school's why/purpose.
- Leader articulates technical and adaptive challenges immediately relevant to their context and implementation.
- Leader has basic understanding of PBL/project design.
- Leader has a basic understanding of a culture of Trust, Respect, and Responsibility.
- Leader has a basic understanding of the role of Echo/technology in the New Tech model.
- Leader produced a viable draft of the entry event for Teacher Residency.
- Leader recognizes her/his responsibility to facilitate inquiry and learning for the school team.
- Leader completes SWOT analysis that reflects critical thought about existing school/system policies and structures.
- Leader identifies next steps that include immediate actions related to the school's current culture and practice. Next steps are informed by the nature of the challenge (technical vs. adaptive).

### **Teacher Residency Goals**

- Build cohesion among your team through a shared deeper learning experience.
- Experience a New Tech school in action.
- Learn about the essentials of the New Tech model and how they contribute to school success.
- Begin planning for how you create an environment that will lead to your ideal graduate(s).
- Create a vision of the type of staff culture that you need to have and identify the shifts that need to happen to create that culture.

### **NTN 101 New Schools Training – Leadership Principles & Practices Objectives**

- Knowledge of 5 Domains for Leadership Development.
- Growing skill set around facilitating inquiry.
- Understanding of design features of learning systems.
- Ability to leverage Hierarchy of Change.
- Knowledge of PBL process and possible supports for adult learning.
- Ability to distinguish adaptive challenges from technical problems.
- Working draft of the design for your adult learning system.
