

**OPEN/CLOSED CAMPUS**

In order to give grades **10 (second semester only)**, and 11-12 students an opportunity to demonstrate responsibility and positive citizenship, the Governing Board establishes an open campus at all district high schools in which students **may under specific conditions** have the privilege of leaving campus during lunch.

The privilege of open campus may be revoked from individual students for **disciplinary, attendance or by written parent request** reasons.

*(cf. 5144 - Discipline)*

Students shall not leave the school grounds at any other time during the school day without written permission of their parents/guardians and school authorities. Students who leave school or who fail to return following lunch without authorization shall be classified truant and subject to disciplinary action.

## OPEN/CLOSED CAMPUS

*Open/Closed Campus Rules and Procedures – PAJUHSD*

*The rules and procedures for off campus privileges are as follows:*

1. *Only grades 10, 11, and 12 are eligible to apply for off-campus lunch privileges. Grade 9 has a closed campus for all purposes.*
2. *Students who are eligible for off-campus lunch privileges must have a signed parent consent on file at the school before an off campus pass will be granted.*
3. *To be eligible for an off campus lunch pass, seniors and juniors must have a 2.0 grade point average (GPA); all students eligible for off-campus privileges must not have any "F" grades on the most recent official grade/progress report.*
4. *Sophomore students can go off campus during second semester only.*
5. *Off campus lunch pass may be revoked for any of the following reasons:*
  - A. ~~*Tardy to 6<sup>th</sup> period*~~ ***Tardy to period right after lunch***
    - 1) *1st offense - one week suspension of off campus lunch pass*
    - 2) *2nd offense - suspension of off campus lunch pass for the remainder of the semester*
    - 3) *3rd offense - off campus lunch pass revoked for the rest of the school year*
  - B. *Any truancy from any class period*
    - 1) *1st offense - one week suspension of off-campus lunch pass*
    - 2) *2nd offense - suspension of off-campus lunch pass for the remainder of the semester*
    - 3) *3rd offense - off campus lunch pass revoked for the rest of the school year*
  - C. *Progress/grade report shows an "F" grade and a total GPA below 2.0/3.0*

**OPEN/CLOSED CAMPUS**

- 1) *Off campus lunch pass suspended until the next official grade/progress report is posted in Aeries/ECHO and shows a GPA at or above 2.0/3.0 and no "F" grades*
  
  - D. *Miss more than one assigned detention per quarter*
    - 1) *1st offense - one week suspension of off-campus lunch pass*
    - 2) *2nd offense - suspension of off campus lunch pass for the remainder of the semester*
    - 3) *3rd offense - off campus lunch pass revoked for the rest of the school year*
  
  - E. *Receive an in-school or out of school suspension for any reason*
    - 1) *1st offense - off campus lunch pass suspended for the remainder of semester*
    - 2) *2nd offense - off campus lunch pass revoked for the rest of the school year*
  
  - F. *Reserved for a drug/alcohol violation*
    - 1) *1st offense - off campus lunch pass suspended for the remainder of the semester*
    - 2) *2nd offense - off campus lunch pass revoked for the rest of the school year*
  
  - G. *Forged parent consent form*
    - 1) *Off campus pass revoked for the rest of the school year*
6. *Students must carry their off campus lunch pass at all times, and must present the pass when requested by any district employee or law enforcement.*
