

## **Freshman year:**

Work with those students who plan to attend college to make sure they are enrolled in the right courses to make college attendance possible.

Start taking Practice SAT/ACT exams in realistic conditions (2/yr.?)

## **Sophomore year:**

Take Preparatory Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT)

Take practice SAT/ACT tests – Two per month? Note: These tests will be individually examined to find out on what subject areas a student is deficient. The student will then be tutored/study those areas to become more proficient.

Take a course on the structure of an SAT/ACT test, how to take the test, how to tell possible answers based on question framework. Khan Academy offers free courses in area.

Continue to take practice SAT/ACT test

## **Junior:**

Continue to take tests

Register to take actual ACT/SAT tests

## **Possible Costs:**

1. SAT/ACT tests
2. Possible commercial educational products that fit our students well
3. Instructional time from teacher/mentor
