Missing Immunizations and Health records for School

This is a reminder for those families with missing immunizations and missing school entry health exams.

On January 3, 2023, students with missing immunizations and missing entry exam records will be **excluded** from attending school as per Immunization requirement (SB 277). A final letter will be mailed home next week. Please check with your child's health care provider for missing immunizations and bring a copy to school as soon as possible.

California requires students TK/Kindergarten through 12th grade to have the following immunizations:


Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTaP, DTP, Tdap, or Td) — 5 doses. ...

Polio (OPV or IPV) — 4 doses. ...

Hepatitis B — 3 doses. ...

Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) — 2 doses. ...

Varicella (Chickenpox) — 2 doses.
