Things to Know

MAKE A PLAN

Planning ahead is key to a successful school experience the first week, first month or first year for your child. **Place a note in your child's school bag or lunchbox providing updated physical & mailing addresses, and current telephone numbers.** This helps the teacher and staff members to contact you, a family member or friend when your child needs you. The first week of school is extremely busy for the office processing students' Back to School forms and may not have this new information available.

MEAL TIME

Is your child ordering a school lunch the first week? Please send a note to your child's teacher indicating if your child will order a school lunch or will bring a lunch from home. Our school participates in the Universal Benefits Application (UBA) program and our students eat free meals (breakfast and lunch) each day. An August Meal Menu is included in your packet.

DISMISSAL

How is your child getting home from school (riding the bus home, picked up from school)?

Please **plan ahead** and discuss with your child where they are going after school.

Please send a note to school indicating where he/she will go at dismissal time. Example: My child will ride the bus home, or be picked up at school, or will go to daycare, or lives locally and will walk home (*grades TK-1st must be accompanied by an adult or older sibling to walk home*).

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM for Grades TK through 8th

The Kudos After School Program (ASP) begins the second day of school, Thursday, August 20, 2026 for students who have returned the completed after school packet prior to Wednesday, August 19. There is a one-day wait period before any student begins the program. All after school program applications are included in the Back-To-School packet.

HAZ UN PLAN

Nuestro colegio participa en el programa de Solicitud de Beneficios Universales (UBA) y nuestros alumnos comen comidas gratis (desayuno y comida) todos los días.

En tu paquete se incluye un menú de comidas de agosto.

DESTITUCIÓN

¿Cómo va tu hijo a volver a casa desde el colegio (viajando en autobús y recogiendo al colegio)?

Por favor, **planifica con** antelación y habla con tu hijo sobre dónde irá después del colegio.

Por favor, envía una nota al colegio indicando a dónde irá a la hora de la salida. Ejemplo: Mi hijo irá en autobús a casa, o será recogido en el colegio, irá a la guardería o vivirá cerca y andará a casa (*los cursos de TK a 1º deben ir acompañados por un adulto o un hermano mayor para poder ir andando a casa*).

WELCOME BACK TO THE 2026-27 ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR!

I hope you are all enjoying time with your children over the summer vacation. We are working very hard to get Arena Elementary cleaned, organized and ready for the students to return on Wednesday, August 19th.

Your child/children are in store for many meaningful and exciting learning adventures! For them, let us make the goal to have a successful school year by working together as a team to ensure a quality educational experience.

Here at Arena, our teachers have high expectations and want to foster and encourage the excitement of learning new ideas and concepts. Make sure your children are prepared for the return to school. Here are just a few good tips you might consider:

1. Before the school year begins, start adjusting your child's bedtime so that they get enough sleep, are rested, and functional in the morning. Getting plenty of sleep is important for their learning. When children are exhausted they have extreme difficulty processing information.
2. Limit screen time! Devices should be turned off and put away at least one hour before bedtime. Social media and gaming over-stimulate the brain, which makes it harder for children to fall asleep.
3. Check with your child's doctor to be sure immunizations are up to date, particularly Kindergarten, 7th graders and new students to the district. Additionally, this is a good time to schedule annual sports physical exams, which are required for participation in school sponsored sporting events.
4. Make sure your child has a backpack and age appropriate school supplies on the first day of school.
5. Finally, **please write your child's name on all of their jackets, sweatshirts, sweaters, etc.** Last year we had an over abundance of unclaimed outerwear which had to be washed, folded and donated.

Along with this Welcome Back letter, you will find many important school documents included in the Back-to-School packet which need to be read, personal information to be completed and signed.

En Arena, nuestros maestros tienen altas expectativas y quieren fomentar y alentar el entusiasmo por aprender nuevas ideas y conceptos. Asegúrese de que sus hijos estén preparados para el regreso a clases. Aquí tiene algunos buenos consejos que podría considerar:

1. Antes de que comience el año escolar, comience a ajustar la hora de dormir de su hijo para que duerma lo suficiente, esté descansado y sea funcional por la mañana. Dormir lo suficiente es importante para su aprendizaje. Cuando los niños están agotados, tienen extrema dificultad para procesar la información.
2. ¡Limita el tiempo frente a la pantalla! Los dispositivos deben apagarse y guardarse al menos una hora antes de acostarse. Las redes sociales y los videojuegos sobre estimulan el cerebro, lo que dificulta que los niños se duerman.
3. Consulte con el médico de su hijo para asegurarse de que tenga las vacunas al día, especialmente las de kinder, séptimo grado y los nuevos estudiantes del distrito. Además, este es un buen momento para programar los exámenes físicos deportivos anuales, necesarios para participar en eventos deportivos escolares.
4. Asegúrese de que su hijo tenga una mochila y útiles escolares apropiados para su edad el primer día de clases.
5. Finalmente, **Por favor escriba el nombre de su hijo en todas sus chaquetas, sudaderas, suéteres, etc.** El año pasado tuvimos una gran cantidad de ropa de abrigo sin reclamar que tuvimos que lavar, doblar y donar.

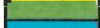
