## ACADEMIC FREEDOM AND DIVERSITY OF THOUGHT

The Board of Trustees ("Board") of the Point Arena Schools ("District") hereby resolves the following in support of academic freedom and diversity of thought in District schools.

WHEREAS, teachers, students, parents and community members have expressed concerns that the Board had and/or were planning to remove (ban) books and/or authors from District school libraries, classrooms, or curriculums; and

WHEREAS, the Board is legally responsible for what is being taught in the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board is committed to enhancing each and every learners' experiences through intellectual and academic freedom, which help advance diverse perspectives; and

WHEREAS, the District has established practices that address the removal of books from libraries and classrooms through a multi-step process that includes public comment and open session Board approval;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board shall support all efforts to provide each and every learner opportunities to think and grow; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board shall ensure equitable access to all books, including those that reflect, respect and celebrate the diverse community we serve; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board acknowledges the trusted role of teachers in the development and presentation of curriculum that promotes critical thinking skills through engagement with and evaluation of a wide range of ideas.
