All students are placed on the A-G track as freshmen and are given support classes and tutoring when needed.

Number of Students: 130

Students have the option to retake any class, and they also have the option to take makeup classes online if in-person offerings don't fit into their schedule during the regular school day.

The related courses will be built into the master schedule. Tutoring will be provided during lunch and after school. The school will host a financial aid night as well as AP prep Saturday school.
