

The Pacific Community Charter School submitted plans to DSA to replace one of their modular classrooms. DSA rejected its submittal stating that the new building must be 20 feet away from the existing non-permitted building that is planned to remain. The existing buildings are about 10 feet apart, or five feet apart measuring from the exit door ramp on the building that remains.

In order for PCCS to move forward they need approval to place the new buildings 30 feet away, from each building or 20 foot separation between ramps.

PCCS's request is to place the new building more westward from the remaining building to achieve the required building separation.
