**Types of Arts Education Programs offered with AMS funds**

The Arena Union Elementary School District (AUESD) spends 2023-2024 AMS funds on materials, supplies, supplemental salaries, benefits, and professional services for arts education offered within the school day and in the After School Program for all Grades TK-8, as well as for the music education Arena Band Program for Grades 4-8. The art program explores mediums such as drawing, painting, mural art, jewelry making, and 3-dimensional crafting. The band program consists of musical theory and performance for wind, percussion, and cordophone instruments. Examples of 2023-24 AMS expenditures include: musical instruments such as guitars and trumpets; art supplies such as tempera paint, construction paper, glue, clay, brushes, etc.; and an Art Fair stipend.
