Types of Arts Education Programs offered with AMS funds

The Point Arena Joint Union High School District spends 2023-2024 AMS funds on materials, supplies, supplemental salaries, benefits, and professional services for our music education Point Arena Band Program as well as for our arts education program, spanning all Grades 9-12. The art program delves into drawing, painting, ceramics, and sculpture for all ability levels. The band program consists of musical theory and performance for wind, percussion, and cordophone instruments. Examples of 2023-24 AMS expenditures include: musical instruments such as trumpets; art and ceramics supplies such as pottery glazes, art drying racks, canvases, framing materials, artist paper, sewing materials, etc.; art services such as an Art of Education curriculum subscription; and Art Show supplemental time.
