Types of Arts Education Programs offered

The Arena Union Elementary School District (AUESD) spends 2024-2025 AMS funds on materials, supplies, supplemental salaries, benefits, and professional services for visual arts and digital related arts education within the school day and in the After School Program for all Grades TK-8, as well as for music education through the Arena Choral Music Program. The art program explores mediums such as drawing, painting, mural art, jewelry making, digital art/technology, and 3-dimensional crafting. The choral music program allows students to discover their voices, and learn about rhythm, song structure, melody, and musical theory. Examples of 2024-25 AMS expenditures include: art supplies such as watercolors, markers, drawing paper, sketchpads, markers, glue, brushes, rhinestones, drafting tools, etc.; and choral music professional services.
