Types of Arts Education Programs offered

The Point Arena Joint Union High School District (PAJUHSD) spends 2024-2025 AMS funds on materials, supplies, supplemental salaries, benefits, and professional services for visual arts, theater, and music programs for all Grades 9-12. PAJUHSD also has a media arts program and a culinary arts program. The traditional arts program delves into drawing, painting, ceramics, and sculpture for all ability levels. Theater introduces students to theaterical arts, allowing them to create, compose, memorize, stage, and perform previously produced works. In media arts students learn how to create and communicate utilizing digital media that includes working with industry software and creating original work. The curriculum for the culinary arts program includes, but is not limited to, teaching students cooking techniques, kitchen safety, nutrition, cooking methods, and meal planning. Examples of 2024-25 AMS expenditures include: art and ceramics supplies such as acrylic paints, markers, prisma colored pencils, spray paint, block print ink, clay, drawing tracers, felting materials, etc.; art services such as an Art of Education curriculum subscription; Art Show supplemental time; and theater materials such as flip forms.
