RESOLUTION NO. PAS- 25-4303

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY PURSUANT TO PUBLIC CONTRACT CODE SECTIONS 1102 AND 20113

WHEREAS, the Point Arena Joint Union High School District ("District") has determined it necessary to replace the boiler in the Point Arena High School Gymnasium ("Facility") due to it no longer producing heat; and

WHEREAS, the conditions must be remedied immediately to ensure that classes can continue through the spring semester and to protect the health and safety of all persons using the Facility; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined the time necessary to go to bid on replacing the boiler would cause the gymnasium to be unusable during the spring semester as the bid process would add a minimum of six weeks to the time necessary to undertake such work; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Contract Code Sections 1102 and 20113, in an emergency, when any repairs, alterations, work or improvement are necessary to permit the continuance of existing school classes, and to avoid danger to life or property, the Board, by unanimous vote, with the approval of the County Superintendent of Schools, may make a contract in writing or otherwise on behalf of the District for the performance of labor and furnishing of materials or supplies for the purpose without advertising for or inviting bids.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the Point Arena School District Governing Board ("Board") has determined, by unanimous vote herein recorded that, pursuant to Public Contract Code Sections 1102 and 20113, for the reasons set forth above, an emergency exists in that there is both a danger to life or property and that unless the work is completed immediately the Facility will be unusable during the spring semester and the District will not have a safe facility for its students; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, upon approval of this Resolution by the Mendocino County Superintendent of Schools, or designee, the District may contract in writing with reputable licensed contractor(s) for the performance of the work required, such contract(s) to be ratified by the Board; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, for any contract exceeding \$25,000 performance and payment bonds will be required.
